Aveiro

- Highest population growth (7%). Better than Central region (-1%) and Portugal (2%)
- Higher working-age population (69%) compared to Central region (64%) and Portugal (66%).
- Lower percentage of population with more than 65 years (17%) compared to Central region (22%) and Portugal (19%) and
- Similar young population (15%) compared to Central region (14%) and Portugal (15%)
- Higher growth of working age population (6%) compared to Central region (-1%) and Portugal (0,7%)

- In Aveiro, the number of accommodations increased more (17,29%) than in Centro region (6,50%) and Portugal (9,78%).
- Given this increase and the increase in population of 7%, the average number of persons by accommodation decreased.
- In 2011, Aveiro recorded a ratio of 1,8 accommodation for building
- Aveiro is a member of Réseau Art Nouveau Network











- Aveiro GDP per capita: 134,8
- Weigher Remuneration of Work: 9.777,90€, when compared with *Centro* Region (7.231,10) and Portugal (8.008€)
- + 9.000 companies + 1.700 self employed
- Employs almost 90% of the working age population (2011)
- Unemployment Rate: 10% & 18,3% of Youth unemployment (2011)

- University's budget ~ 100M€
- young university (1973), pioneer in its educational offer
 - telecommunications, integrated teacher training, ceramics engineering, environmental engineering, regional and urban planning, industrial management and engineering, tourism, music... were innovations at national level
- Promoting and developing local entrepreneurial policies
 - a "single distributed incubator" in several municipalities of the Region of Aveiro
